### Program Overview

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- ▶ The **Teaching and Learning** program is designed to meet the growth and knowledge needs of the experienced teacher.
- ▶ **Cohort model** — students move together as a professional learning community through the required sequence of courses.
- ▶ **Classes meet once a week in the evening**
- ▶ Candidates in the program examine teaching and learning through six comprehensive course modules and the completion of a capstone project.
- ▶ Throughout the program, the emphasis is on the integration of theory, research and application.

- ▶ Submit official copies of undergraduate transcripts showing a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale
- ▶ Submit two current letters of recommendation
- ▶ Applicant must be a practicing teacher and submit documentation of employment in a teaching situation in a pre-K-16 setting.
