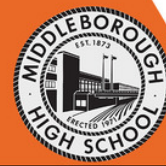
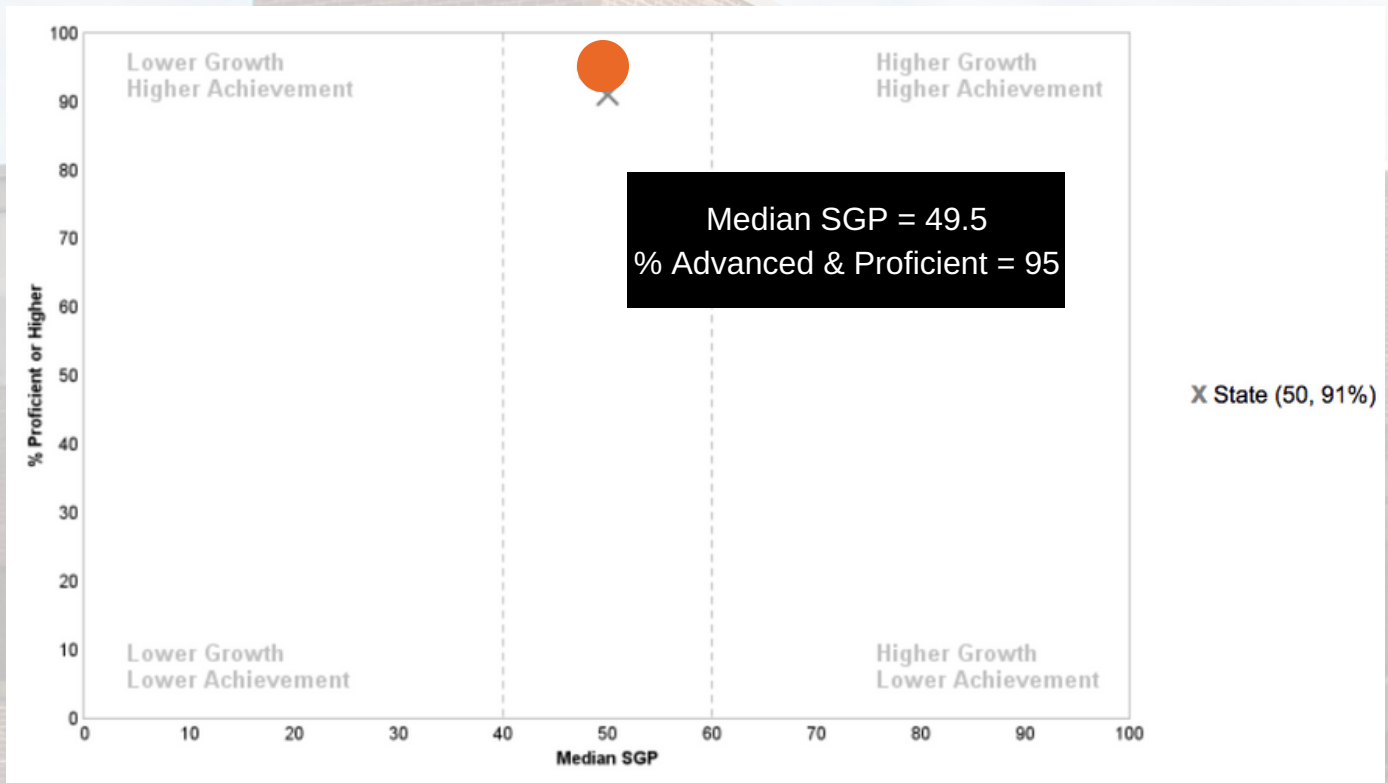


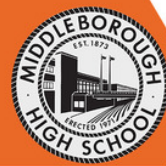
# Middleborough High School Road to Excellence



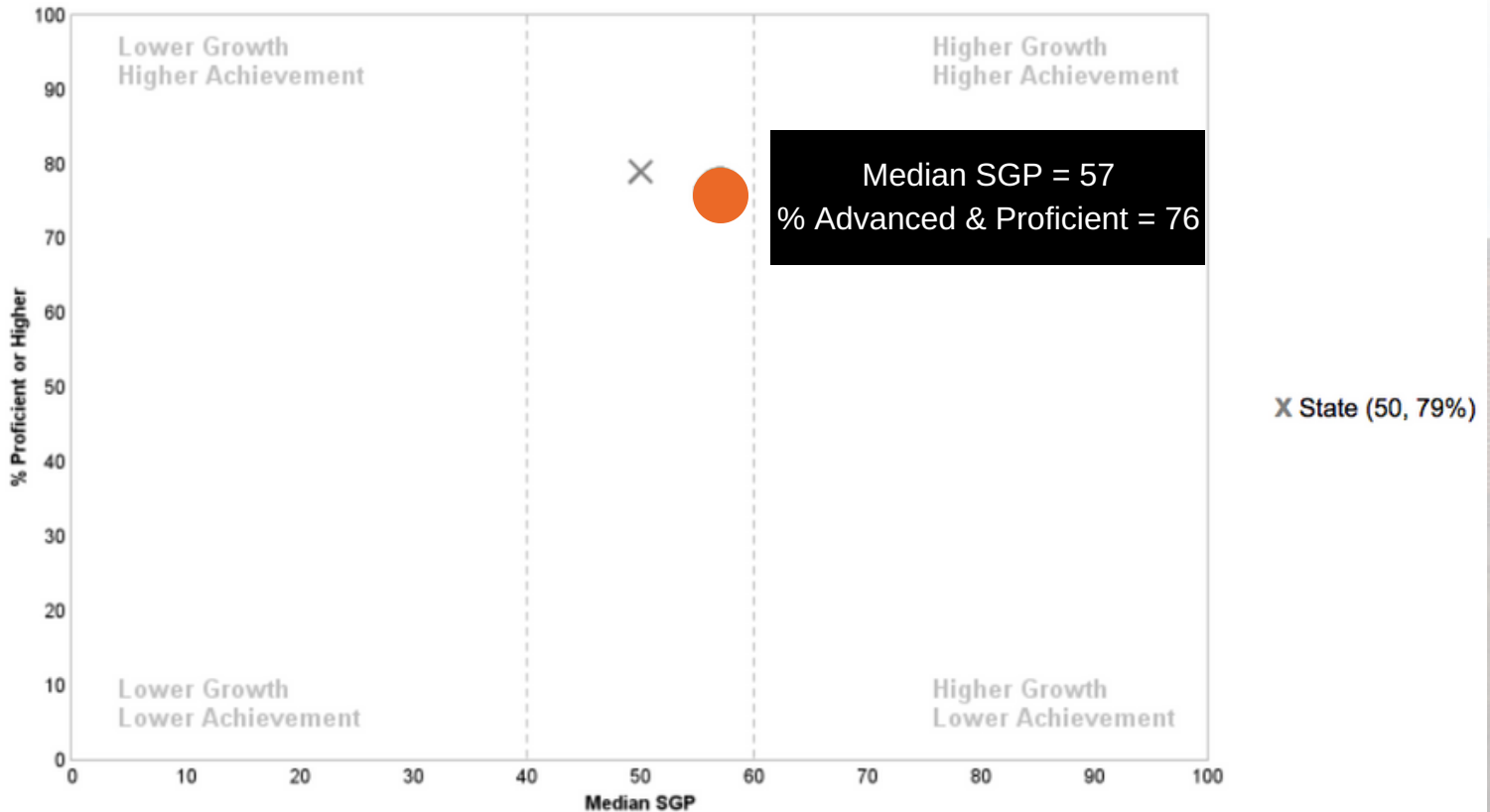
The English Department at Middleborough High School has continued to sustain high achievement on ELA MCAS. The results from 2017 have yielded our highest achievement to date on this assessment, outpacing the State by 4% in advanced and proficient scores. The English Department has been able to achieve these results through consistent application of common rubrics with common writing benchmarks. Consistency in student expectations across the English Department has raised the bar for all students and, as shown by the evidence below, our students are rising to the challenge.



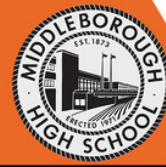
# Middleborough High School Road to Excellence



Since 2012, the Middleborough High School Mathematics Department has undergone a major reconstruction of our written curriculum, including the development and revision of common assessments. This work has resulted in improved outcomes for our students, with some of the largest gains to date in our mathematics performance. It should be noted that our students' median student growth percentile (SGP) has also increased from 25.5 in 2012 to 57 in 2017. The median SGP for our school shows the "typical" growth for our students. As noted in the graphic below with the orange circle, we are approaching higher growth and higher achievement. State data is indicated with the large X.

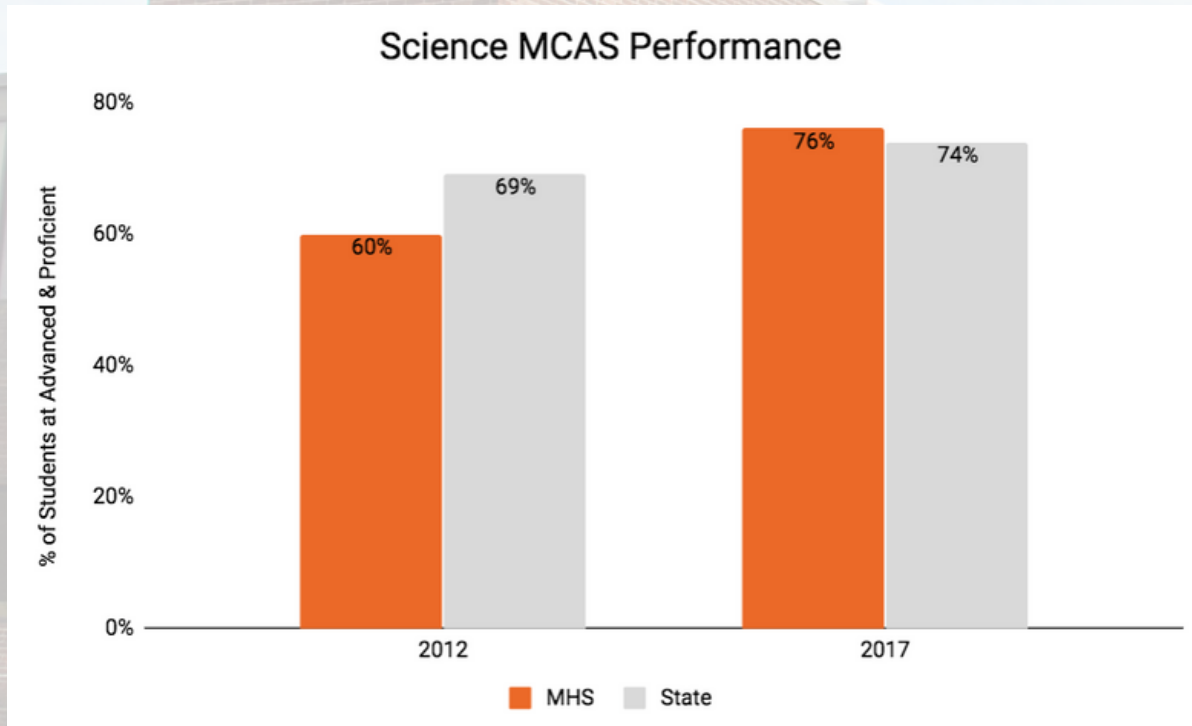


# Middleborough High School Road to Excellence



Students at Middleborough High School take the Biology MCAS during their freshman year; with administrations in February and June each year. Please note that Median Student Growth Percentiles are not awarded in Science since this assessment is not given in consecutive years like ELA and Mathematics MCAS.



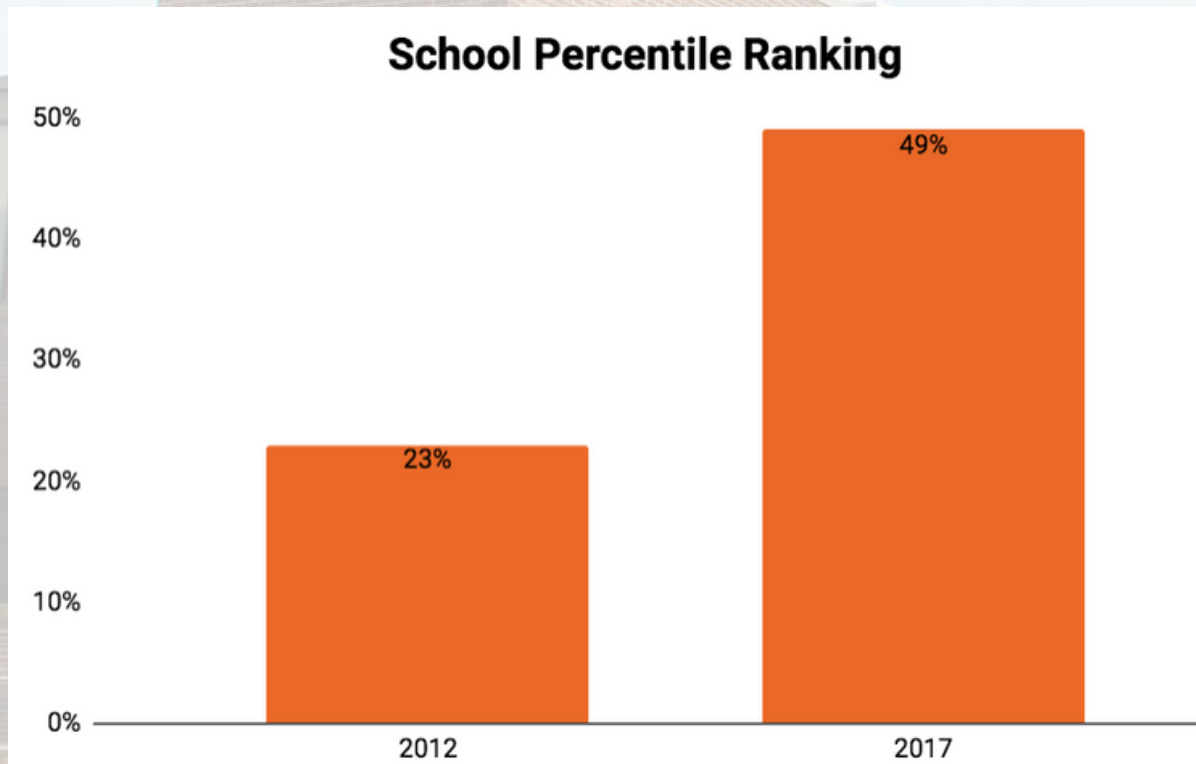


# Middleborough High School Road to Excellence



A school percentile between 1 and 99 is reported for schools with at least four years of MCAS data. This number is an indication of the school's overall performance relative to other schools that serve the same or similar grades. Middleborough High School has vastly improved our school ranking as a result of our students improved performance on MCAS. The current ranking is Middleborough High School's highest level to-date.

MA Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's Accountability System classifies schools in one of five accountability levels, with the highest performing in Level 1 and lowest performing in Level 5. Based upon Middleborough High School's MCAS performance data and school percentile ranking, Middleborough High School is classified as a Level 2 school.

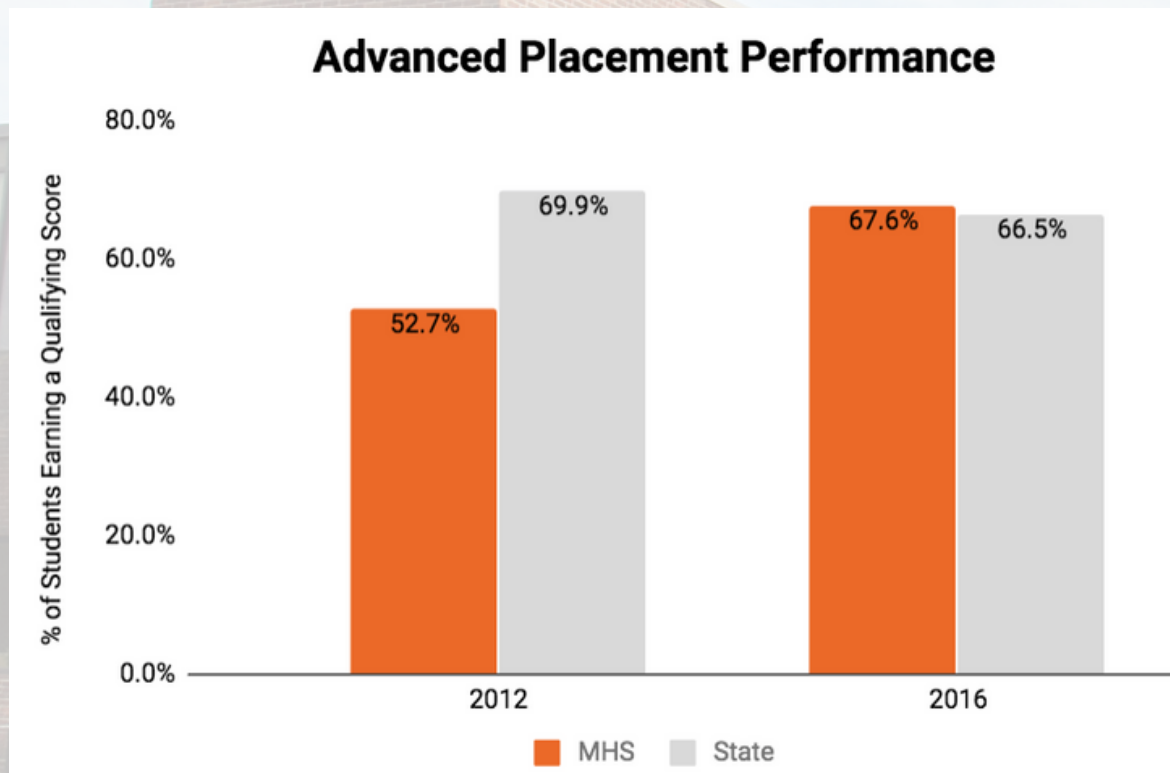


# Middleborough High School Road to Excellence



Middleborough High School has partnered with Mass Insight and the MA Math and Science Initiative in 2010. Since then we have been able to increase the number of Advanced Placement (AP) classes from 4 to 14 with plans for adding more classes moving forward. MHS is proud to be 1 of 36 high schools in MA that participate in the AP Capstone program.

Beyond expanding our AP program, our students have also experienced improvement in the percent of students earning a qualifying score on their respective AP exams. Students that earn qualifying scores have the potential to also earn college credit.

Middleborough High School has experienced a steady decline in its drop-out rate. Through increasing the variety of options to engage our students, more of our students are persevering and finishing high school strong. We offer many programs to support our students: Futures Alternative High School, Links Social & Emotional Program, Project Success, and more.
