

NCAA Registration Time

It is time for college-bound student-athletes to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center.

Who Should Register? Any current high school sophomore, junior or senior who wishes to participate in collegiate athletics at an NCAA Division I or II college or university should register.

How Does Registration Work? Registrants may access the site at www.eligibilitycenter.org. From the home page, click on "Enter Here" for NCAA college-bound student-athletes, then on the "New Account" link in the upper right corner. From there, they simply follow the prompts.

What is the High School's Role? For your current seniors who have registered, you need to send transcripts to the NCAA Eligibility Center. You can access your list of registrants on the NCAA Eligibility Center's High School Portal. Go to www.eligibilitycenter.org and click on the high school administrator link. Log in, then click on "**Student Reports**" to see what students from your school have registered. You will want to send transcripts at the end of the year for both juniors and seniors. Please consider sending an e-transcript rather than a paper transcript, as these are received and processed within 24-48 hours. Directions and information on e-transcripts are on the Resources tab of the High School Portal.
