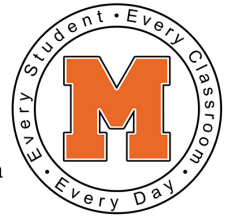

### **Middleborough High School's Traffic and Parking Plan For 2019-2020 School Year**

Due to the current state of our school campus during the new High School Construction Project, a new Traffic and Parking Plan has been created for the duration of this school year. This plan has been created with input and approval from the Middleborough Police Department, the Middleborough High School Building Committee, the MHS Administrative Team, Middleborough Public School Department, and our Owner Project Manager, Architect, and General Contractor.

Effective Tuesday, September 3, 2019, all traffic will enter school grounds from Rt. 28 and immediately turn right on to Braga's Path to head toward the gym in a counter clockwise traffic pattern around the school.

#### **Morning drop off:**

All staff will park in the newly established parking spaces in the front of the building along Braga's Path, the loading dock, and front driveway. These parking spaces are for staff only.

All student drivers will park in either the parking lot by the gym or the former faculty parking lot parking lot to the left of the school. Students will follow the traffic pattern around the school to enter the other student lot (former faculty lot).

All student drop-offs (private vehicle and bus) will occur in the back of the building. These vehicles must pull all the way up to the back left corner of the building before dropping off your students in order to allow for the most cars to stack up and keep traffic moving. These students will enter the building through the cafeteria entrance.

Important: Front door drop-offs are solely reserved for mobility impaired students and authorized vehicles/students ONLY. Parents may drop off at the front entrance after 7:20AM as the back doors will be locked at that time.

#### **During the school day:**

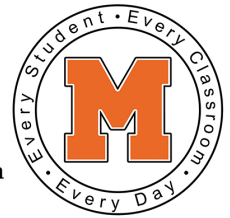

### **Afternoon dismissal/pick-up:**
