

GUIDELINES FOR SCIENCE FAIR DISPLAY

BOARD

What Makes for a Good Science Fair Project Display Board?

Does your display board include:

- Title
- Question – Statement of Problem
- Hypothesis and Variables
- Materials list
- Experimental procedures
- Data analysis and discussion including data chart(s) & graph(s)
- Conclusions (including ideas for future research)

Consider the Following:

1. Are the sections on your display board organized like a newspaper so that they are easy to follow?
2. Is the text font large enough to be read easily (at least 16 points)?
3. Does the title catch people's attention, and is the title font large enough to be read from across the room?
4. Did you use pictures and diagrams to effectively convey information about your science fair project?
5. Have you constructed your display board as neatly as possible?
6. Did you proofread your display board?
